

Report on Teacher Training Group Meeting

Dear colleagues from teacher training group this is a summary of what we agreed on in Sofia. We discussed the possibility to apply for a new project which we call Virtual Campus.

Every country is very welcome to take part in this promising future project.

If you are interested and want to participate, please contact the Norwegian party (Tor Risnes) or the Portugese party (Jaime Santos). Would you please do so by the end of June 2007.

In Sofia was also announced the conference "Migration and Teachers Training in Contemporary Europe" which will take place at the end of October and the beginning of November in České Budějovice and Prague, the Czech Republic.

Here are the details we have discussed so far:

1. The idea is to open a virtual campus for students from our countries. The focus should be on international cooperation.
2. The campus should last for three months (which is one term at the university), at the end the students would have the opportunity to meet each other in person and they could discuss their experience with the course. We feel that feedback and final meeting of the students is a very important part of our project.
3. Tor Risnes from Norway has been asked to find more information about the technical background of the project and he promised to do so.
4. Jaime Santos from Portugal has been asked to do a questionnaire to find out how people feel about the idea of an university campus and promised to do so.
5. Lenka Hessova from the Czech Republic has been asked to send out an information letter about this future project to all the members of teacher training group and she promised to do so.
6. We would like to ask all the participants to think about the content of our virtual campus. There will be a pool of ideas during our next meeting, where we choose our content.
7. We would like to meet again and discuss futher actions. We have not agreed on a concrete day and place because we are waiting for the final number of participants. Once we know who is in the meeting will be arranged.

This is the summary of what has been planned and discussed. Thank you for having read this short report and we hope to hear from you soon.
